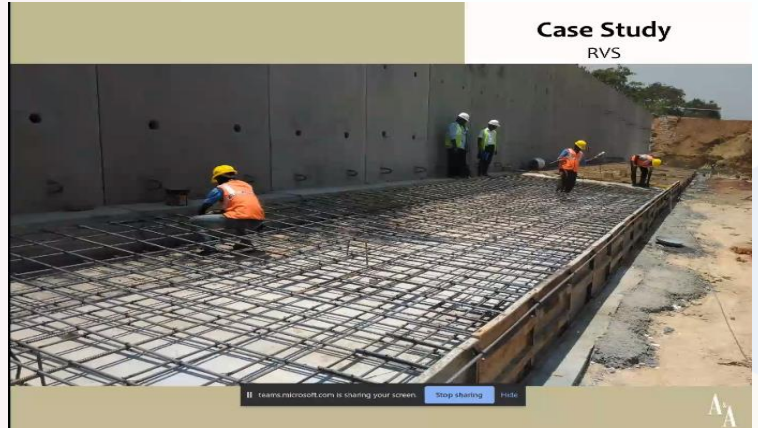
Two days Daylight Simulation Workshop is conducted for Bachelor's & Master's students for using Rhino-Grasshopper & honeybee-Ladybug.

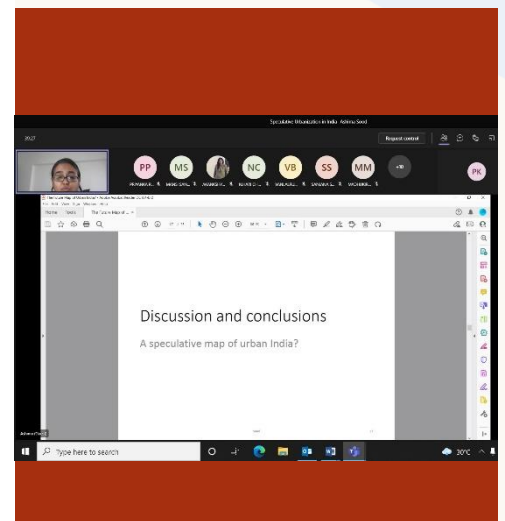
Abstract: What is the nature and scale of greenfield urban development in post-2000 India? This paper presents findings from a novel database of mega-urban developments, compiled from a private dataset of real estate investments. We argue that the geographic spread and nature of initiative in upcoming developments highlight a noticeable shift in the direction of the urban development agenda in India. This study suggests remarkable forms of geographic polarization, with large-scale private actors in real estate consolidating urban development in metropolitan India while the majority of India's urban population in smaller urban centres relies on unorganized builders. This emerging speculative map of urban India has implications for governance, migration patterns, informal urban growth and socio-spatial inequalities in resource use that we are only beginning to trace.

About the Speaker: Dr Sood's work has combined qualitative and quantitative methods to examine the forms and origins of informality in Indian cities. Her research has been published in avenues ranging from *Urban Studies*; *Cities*; *Territory, Politics, Governance*; *Journal of Institutional Economics*; *Marg*, *the Economic and Political Weekly*; the *India International Centre Quarterly*, to the *Wiley-Blackwell Encyclopaedia of Urban and Regional Research* and the *World Social Science Report 2013*, and others.
