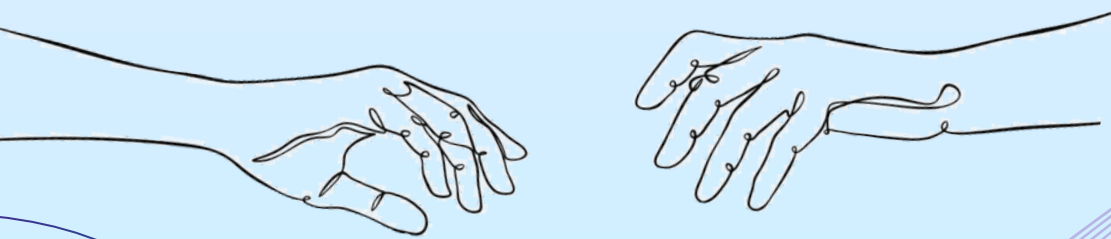

It provides liaison clinics with various specialities, including psychiatry, paediatrics, neurology, dermatology, surgery, and oncology. Additionally, the department offers specialized training in rehabilitating chronic mental illness at its university rehabilitation centre. The department offers three programs: B.Sc in Clinical Psychology, M.Sc in Clinical Psychology, and M.Phil in Clinical Psychology.
